Many types of sources (reference books, articles, statistics, etc.)

## **ProQuest**

- Put phrases in quotes
- Try field searching (such as subject heading)
- Use thesaurus to verify subject headings

# **Academic Search Complete**

Similar to ProQuest, but has some unique content

#### **BOOKS**

#### **One Search Box**

- Can also search for & request books for GU and other partner libraries
- Search many (but not all) library resources at once

## **eBook Collection**

Library database that contains 150,000 ebooks
