

NCLR ADMINISTRATIVE LEADERSHIP AWARD

ELIGIBILITY:

Any community college administrator, excluding those whose positions are directly learning resources related. The nominator or the institution must be a member of NCLR.

CRITERIA:

A nominee for the award should evidence significant support for the learning resources program, which has resulted in:

- improved funding/increased staffing
- increased uses of technology
- enabled cooperative efforts with other agencies
- extended services to patrons
- enhanced physical facilities
- the development of innovative programming

In assessing the individual's contribution, the judges will pay particular attention to the role of the nominee in the success of the project.

JUDGING AND AWARD:

A \$500 scholarship will be given to the awardee's institution in his/her name, and the individual will be honored by the NCLR at the April 2008 American Association of Community Colleges (AACC) Convention in Philadelphia, PA.

NOMINATION PROCESS:

The nomination packet should consist of:

- an information page listing nominee's name, position, community college affiliation (college, district or other), college address, college telephone number, and the nominator's name, position, community college affiliation, college address and telephone number, fax and e-mail;
- a written narrative not to exceed three double-spaced pages describing the nominee's advocacy role in the development of the learning resources program (extra letters of support from individuals who can comment on this person's impact on libraries are encouraged);
- Electronic submission of the information will be greatly appreciated.
